8. **What grade levels is this website suitable for?** It is primarily geared towards PK-5, but some games provided, such as a periodic table of elements game, can be suitable for older students. The website claims these activities can be used by all ages, including high schoolers and adults but the games seem too juvenile for this demographic.
9. **Provide a brief description of the website:**

This website provides games, quizzes, articles, and activities for a wide variety of subject areas. Each subject area has both an icon and words for assistance in navigation around the site. This would be especially helpful for younger learners who would be able to identify a picture more easily than words. The articles provided in each subject area are brief but straightforward. For elementary students, this website gives plenty of information for the student to be informed about a subject but not be overwhelmed by subject specific vocabulary. Additionally, while perusing the site, children are directed through clickable links only to other pages within the site. This means the content students are accessing is safe content that has been looked through and approved by the editor. There is also a section where teachers can contact the editor if they have any suggestions regarding the content on the site.

10. What standards and objectives will the use of this website address?

This website addresses a variety of subject area standards and objectives, including those related to science, math, history, language arts, geography, and art. I found this website to enhance a lesson targeted at teaching the 4th grade science TEK, 9 (B) “describe the flow of energy through food webs, beginning with the Sun, and predict how changes in the ecosystem affect the food web such as a fire in a forest”.

11. Prerequisites (e.g. prior knowledge, reading ability, vocabulary level, etc.):

For PK-K topics, the site audibly gives information about icons on the page when hovered over by a mouse or clicked on. For example, a game aimed at the goal of teaching students the names of different colors, will verbally tell students the colors of different objects when they hover over or select that object’s image. For older students, games, quizzes, and articles require reading ability as there is not a read aloud option, but these activities do not require much prior knowledge as they are giving students the foundational information and skills for the topics being researched. All vocabulary utilized, whether audibly or in print, is accessible for students from prekindergarten and up.

12. What are the top 3 website strengths (from the rubric):

This website has many “high quality” ratings according to the rubric provided below. Of these strengths, the top three I chose are:

- Standards/outcomes/ objectives addressed and use of Web resource should enhance student learning.
 - The games and activities provided on the site enhancing student learning by engaging students whilst requiring them to apply knowledge. This allows students to interact fully with content to more effectively internalize the information.
- Topic is presented so that students are likely to be interested and actively engaged in learning.
 - The games and activities are engaging, creating buy-in amongst students.
- Use of Web resource gives students many opportunities to engage in new learning experiences.
 - Each new page students are directed to has games, illustrations, texts, or activities that keep the student engaged while navigating the site.

13. What are the top 3 website limitations (from the rubric):

The top three limitations from the rubric are listed below:

- Information is correct, but does contain material that is out of date.
 - Since there was no copyright date or date of last update provided, the user cannot assume that all material is up to date.
- The user guide is good resource for use in a lesson. Directions may help teachers and/or students use the material.
 - The homepage and main page to each concept provide minimal directions that assist users in utilizing the material, but these directions could be made clearer.
- Navigation is logical for main use, but can be confusing.

- Navigating from the homepage to subject specific pages is logical, however, if the user wanted to get back to the homepage from the specific content area page they clicked on, the clickable link is sometimes more difficult to find or unavailable.

14. Website Special Features:

This website features interactive games and quizzes that coincide with article content. This allows students to interact with information more fully and internalize content. For younger learners, content is provided audibly. Also, if you are a teacher, some of the software is available to download free of charge so it can be used on devices without internet connection.
